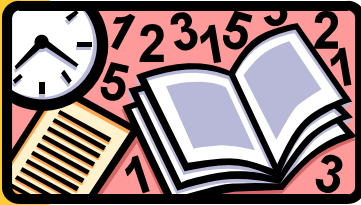

Library times may be scheduled for instruction in developing subtopics, note taking, organization, and citing sources, as well as for instruction in print Reference materials, and online database and internet searches.

We can set up a research project for your students using the forms summarized on the right, and contained in this packet. These and the other forms will be modified to meet the needs of your students and their research.

Student Project Organizer

Teacher & students use this page to define the research task, determine type of final report, and set dates (timeline) for parts of the research to be completed.

Self Assessment

rubric is a tool to help students assess the progress of their work, and can be used by the teacher for grading the project.

Research Organizer

(Part A: Questions sheet) Students write question they want their research to answer; then similar questions are grouped.

Research Organizer

(Part B: Subtopics-Keywords) Using their grouped questions, students develop subtopics and list key words to help in their searches.

Note Cards pages are copied for students to use, includes a sheet that explains the placement of information as students write notes.

Citations pages show students the information they need to list for each source they use in their research.
