## A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

Dear Lincoln School Parents/Guardians:

With spring comes the New York State ELA and Mathematics Tests. These assessments are just one measure of your child's achievement according to the NYS Common Core learning standards. They are also important tools as we look at our programs and your child's academic progress.

School 22 students are on their way to being thoroughly prepared for these assessments. They have been familiarized with the general types of questions and the procedures they should follow when recording their answers.

In order to encourage your child to do his or her best without causing anxiety, I suggest the following:

- Allow sufficient rest and relaxation on the nights before testing.
- If your child does not have breakfast at school, provide a nutritious breakfast on the morning of the test.
- Ensure that your child leaves home in a calm and relaxed frame of mind on the morning of the test.
- Ensure your child arrives to school on time. Once testing has started, latecomers cannot enter the testing area.
- To minimize distractions, please remind your child to keep his/her cellphone in backpack or to give to teachers before testing.
- The ELA exam will be given on April 16th –18th
- The Math exam will be given on April 26th –28

One of the best ways to help your child with math is to have him/ her practice facts at home every day for 10 minutes. Below is a chart showing what is expected at each grade-level.

Grade	My child should be able to:
K	Add and subtract up to 5
1	Add and subtract up to 10
2	Add and subtract up to 20
3	Multiply and divide within 100 Add and subtract within 1,000
4	Add and subtract up to 1,000,000
5	Multiply multi-digit numbers
6	Divide multi-digit numbers + - x ÷ with decimal numbers
