Parent Information Corner

Parents often ask "How can I help my students with learning at home?" In an attempt to answer this important question, we are going to revisit the School goals and offer suggestions for implementing them at home.

For example, **Goal #2** is **Higher Level Questioning Leading to Higher level problem solving skills.**

"Asking open-ended questions that don't have one "right" answer gives children confidence to respond in creative ways without being afraid of being wrong."

For example instead of asking who was the main character in the book they have just read, ask them to think about similar situations in their own life and how they might respond compared to the character.
