- 2. Additions- PD- Half Days- A discussion was had regarding SBPT planning the PD for the half days. At any time, any member of the organization can bring a suggestion to the Leadership team. As far as the SBPT planning the half day PD slots, team members will go back to their grade level team and discuss possible PD opportunities that can be brought back to SBPT.
- 3.
