Dear Parents.

Many of us are enjoying the double digit weather days as we have had a VERY cold February. Thank you to the parents who sent your students to school daily, despite the cold. As you know, attendance is one of the goals of the RCSD. Our attendance had been 94.5% through January; however during the month of February we fell to an average daily attendance of about 90%. Now that the weather is on the upward move, we are looking for improved attendance at Montessori Academy.

The American Montessori Society Annual Conference has just ended. We were fortunate that Mrs. Sciolino and Mrs. Francis were able to join me in Philadelphia for four days. 
