## Bring To College Goal NY on January 29:

at least one parent
a list of the colleges you are applying to
your Social Security number
your parent's Social Security number (if they have one)
your parent's date of birth
your driver's license number (if you have one)
your Alien Registration Number (if you're not a US citizen)
your 2015 federal and New York State tax returns, if applicable
your parent's 2015 federal and New York State tax returns, if applicable
if you and/or your parent did not file 2015 tax returns, please bring all 2015 W-2 forms or last 2015 pay stub, and a list of all other income you and your parents received in 2015, such as: child support, unemployment comp, disability, etc. Families are no longer required to report Social Security income or public assistance on the FAFSA, so information about these is not needed
no need to apply for an FSA ID in advance – we prefer that you do it with us at CGNY.
