CAREY GABAY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

New scholarship program will provide five full scholarships to SUNY colleges for outstanding students from disadvantaged backgrounds

Carey Gabay Memorial Scholarship, a student must meet the following conditions:

- Student must be a current New York State resident;
- Student must be an incoming freshman at a State University of New York State operated campus who will be matriculated and enrolled full time;
- Student must demonstrate significant financial need as determined by the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Student's high school record must demonstrate high academic achievement, including a minimum cumulative grade point average of 90;
- Student must submit an essay regarding challenges overcome during the course of the student's academic career, as well as his or her personal commitment to mentoring, leadership, and social justice; and
- Student must submit two letters of recommendation from teachers or community members

Deadline date: March 15, 2016.

Charlotte Community Association Scholarship – CCA encourages students who live in Charlotte to further their education and be involved in the community through volunteer work. Money is raised through several fund raising activities throughout the year to support 2 – 1000.00 scholarships.
