Middle School Parent Survey Results

- Sent home in backpack mail, Spanish version available, sent to PTSA e-mail list, shared on middle school Facebook page
- 48 responses (10% return is not bad; note that industry average is 3-5% returns)
- Top four issues:
 - 1. Better communication to parents
 - 2. More opportunities for middle school students in their major
 - 3. More academic opportunities
 - 4. More positive school culture
- Two lowest issues:
 - Family Social Events
 - Improvements to fall orientation (this is good news suggests this year's orientation is meeting the needs)
- Key suggestions for number one issue: communication
 - Monthly e-newsletter e-mailed to parents

- Sports bulletin sent prior to each sports season
 - Try-out dates, coach contact info, when/where practices are, preseason work-out schedule
 - Schedule is currently on the website LOVE THIS tryout dates, coach contact info should be there, too
