- Is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offering the prestigious Diploma Programme (DP), and the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP), in partnership with Wilson Foundation Academy.
- Partners with the University of Rochester to offer the Wilson IB Promise Scholarship to all graduating IB seniors, which awards a four-year tuition scholarship to any Wilson Magnet IB Diploma recipient who applies and is accepted into the University of Rochester.
- Has a rigorous curriculum that nurtures creativity and growth, caring teachers and staff, and community partnerships with an emphasis on values and citizenship. Wilson requires a minimum of 25.5 credits to graduate. The New York State requirement is 22 credits.
- Along with current course requirements for college, all 9th and 10th graders are required to complete an MYP personal project and 40 hours of community service.
