ELA and Skills

We are learning about Folktales and Fables such as Goldilocks and the 3 bears and other classic tales. Students will be learning about the In Skills, we are learning sounds for the lowercase letters: d, m, t, c, g, a, i, and o. you can review sounds using any word combinations (see side panel). Have students give sound for each letter in word then have them sing the sounds so they can hear the word as they sing. Any work that you can do to assist in these skills is greatly appreciated. Please make sure to read the parent letters when they come home. They provide book titles and other activities you can do at home to enhance your child's education.
