### Introduction to Medical Health Sciences

An introductory course that engages scholars in the study of the fundamental concepts of Medical Health Sciences. Scholars will focus on human body systems, including both structure and function, with the emphasis on diseases, disorders, and biomedical therapies. Key biological concepts including homeostasis, metabolism, inheritance of traits, and defense against disease are studied. Scholars will also learn about healthcare's history & current trends, develop medical vocabulary, and understand how different healthcare professionals play a vital role in an individual's health care. Scholars will attain basic health literacy and advocacy skills and become certified in Basic Life Support (CPR, AED, and First Aid).
