Adding students to your class

1. Click Manage Students Tab

2. Click Add students

3. **Click Transfer Students-if your students are not in the Raz-Kids system to transfer, you will need to add students.

4. Add Students-Type in the student name and select an Assignment/Reading Level. **No Apostrophe in name

6. Click SAVE

MANAGE STUDENTS-Reports

Activity Report **Default is 7 day view-can modify

- View class activity in Raz-Kids
- How many times logged in
- Minutes Logged in
- Number of books heard
- Number of books read
- Number of quizzes taken
- Number of recordings of themselves
- Number of stars earned
- Their Rank overall
- Raz-Kids levels completed
- Time spent in Raz-Rocket/# of visits
- Time spent in Robot Builder/# of visits

Assignment Progress Report to view student groups/student progress in reading level.

Class Skill Report to view how whole class is performing on Common Core Standards & Reading Comprehension Skills.

Assessment Report to view Reading Running Records (online/paper), High Frequency & Alphabet Assessments.

MANAGE STUDENTS-Reports-(Progress Monitor)

Gives you the option of evaluating a specific student or the entire class.

Classroom Reports:

- Activity Report
- Assignment Progress-View Student groups
- Assessments-Running Records-RRR
- Practice Recordings (Manage Students-In Basket)
- Skill Report-Accuracy % success rate on skill

Individual Student Reports:

Must click on Student Name & click on Report Tab

- Activity
- Assignment Progress
- Level Progress-set Date
- Reading Rate-RRR
- Quiz Skills-Accuracy % success rate for each skill

MANAGE STUDENTS-(Edit Student Profile)

- Click on a student name
- Click on Edit (Pencil by student name)

1. Student Settings

*Book Room *Raz Rocket *Robot Builder

2. Book Room Settings

- Select what range of book levels you want the student to view (Leveled/Spanish books)
- Select access to trade, nursery rhymes, poetry, song books and more

3. Class Chart Location

4. **Password**-default setting is No Password.

- Select Text
- Select One or two red icons

5. Parent Access-parents can view student progress if they provide an email address or they can log in using information from the parent letter

6. **Student Message**-send message to student and send bonus stars based on work.

MANAGE STUDENTS-In Basket

Green-# of Assessments waiting for Review

Orange-# of Practice Recordings waiting for Review

- Review student recording done during independent work **quick formative assessment & check fluency
- Listen to Student Recordings waiting to be scored for Reading Running Record (RRR)
- Enter previous paper RRR

MANAGE STUDENTS-Assignments

Assign a Reading Running Record

- Select the type of Assessment
 - Running Reading Record (RRR)
 - Alphabet Assessment
 - High Frequency Word Assessment
- Follow the steps based on the type of Assessment selected

Create Custom Assignment

- Create a name of assignment
- Choose the student(s)
- Select the books
- Select listen, read only boxes
- Click Done-Save Assignment

***Custom Assignments for:

- Theme/topic-Social Studies & Science
- Motivation / Interest
- Listening at higher level books
