What Students Can Expect from This Course

This is the first half of a two-year course for your child to earn one credit of World Language by the end of 8th grade. Upon successful completion of this course the student will:

- Be able to participate in basic conversations.
- Be able to ask and answer basic questions.
- Be able to create with the language.
- Be able to read simple texts and write short paragraphs.
- Get into, through, and out of a simple survival or social situations.

Topics Covered:

- **Intro:** alphabet, numbers, months, days of the week, greetings, weather
- **Personal ID:** activities and expressions for likes/dislikes; adjectives; personality
- **Education:** classroom items; parts of the classroom; prepositions
- **Meal Taking:** foods, beverages, expressions to show surprise and discuss health.
- **Community & Neighborhood:** leisure activities; places in the community; activities outside school.
- **Family:** family members, possessive adjectives, family descriptions, expressing age
