


East 7-Year Enrollment Trends  
(All Students, SWDs, ELL)






## NYS 6-8 Math Assessment Results



**Additional Noticings/Summary Statements:**

- East’s graduation rate has increased from 33% in 2014-2015 (Pre-EPO) to 70% in 2018-2019 (EPO Year 4). This growth includes increases in the % of the total cohort receiving both Regents and Local diplomas, though the increase in Regents diplomas far surpasses the slight increase in local diplomas. Of the total cohort:
  - Both the number and % of students graduating with a Regents diploma have increased from 85 students (26%) to 104 students (58%), a +32% difference.
  - The number of students graduating with a local diploma has decreased from 22 to 20 students, though due to the smaller cohort size, the % graduating with a local diploma has increased slightly from 7% to 11%, a +4% difference.


