








Which grade levels represent your child(ren)? (select all that apply)




















How do you feel about the communication you are receiving from your teacher/school?






I am comfortable riding a bus to and from school with the regular number of student passengers as long as CDC guidelines are being followed.



I believe in-person school should resume after 10 weeks, where students go to school in a hybrid model (in-person and remote), with procedures in place to reduce the spread of illness.




If the District continues with remote learning, how would this impact your family?








