2. Information on the Contract for Excellence

Information, Presentation: A. Contract for Excellence

President Elliott noted that the Rochester City School District is conducting a public hearing to gather input for submission to the New York State Education Department regarding the Contract for Excellence.

The Contract for Excellence is based on a New York State law, which requires specific school districts to develop a plan to improve academic achievement, particularly for students with the greatest educational needs. The plan is required for school districts with at least one school identified as "in corrective action", "restructuring", or "in need of improvement".

Any additional State funding provided for the Contract for Excellence must be used to support continuing programs or to develop new initiatives, which primarily boost the achievement of students with the greatest need, such as those in poverty, with disabilities, and English-language learners.

Each year, the District is required to submit a fiscal summary and narrative to the New York State Education Department to demonstrate our compliance with the Contract for Excellence requirements. The budgeted General Fund expenditures are identified in the fiscal plan by school and purpose. The District counts three categories of instructional programs to meet our Contract for Excellence maintenance of effort: Time on Task, English Language Learner programs, and Districtwide programs.
