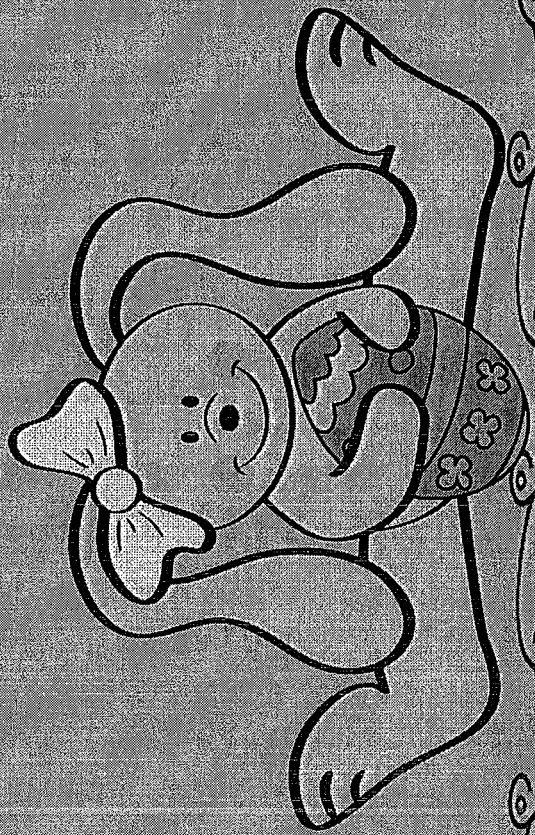

Laminate and cut out the words below. Have students sort them onto the sorting mats.

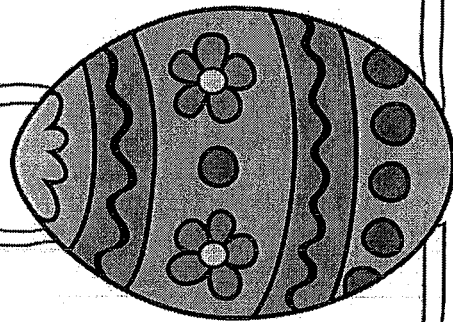
Once they have sorted all the words have them read the words to you.

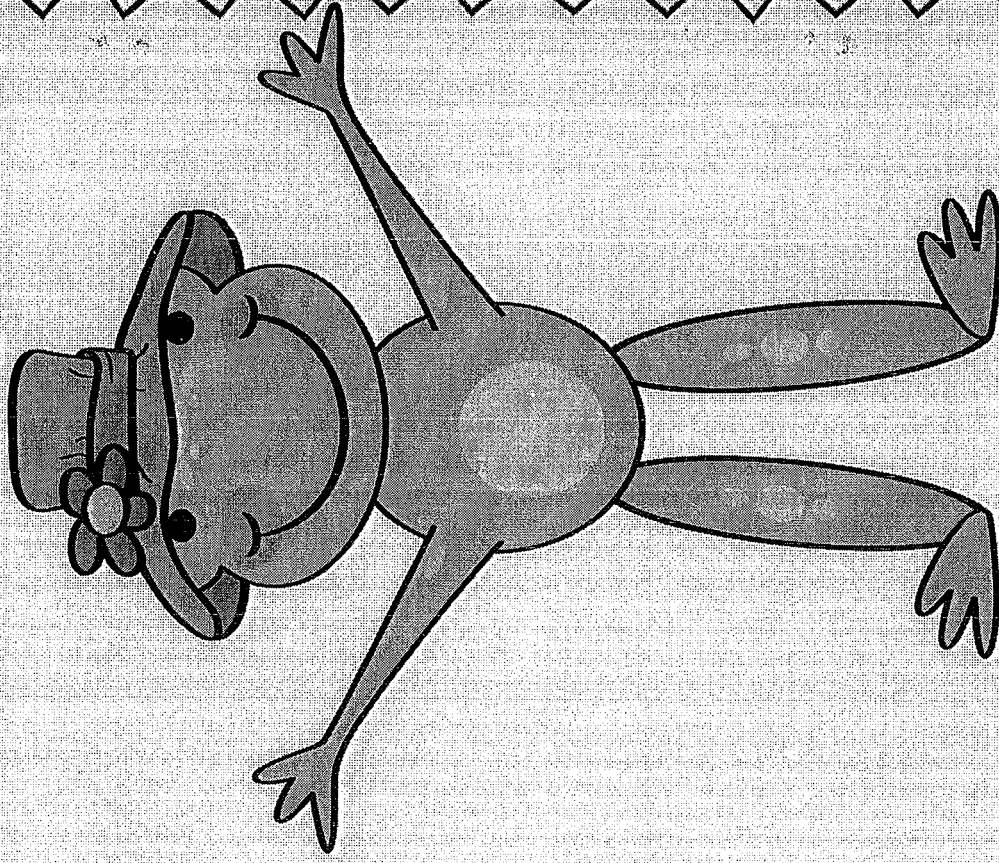


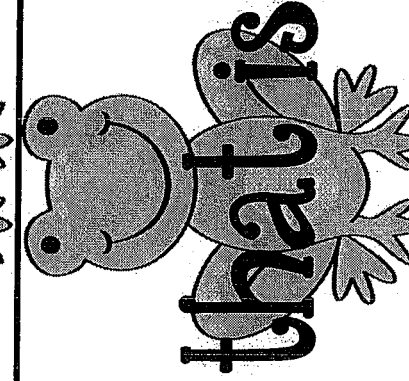
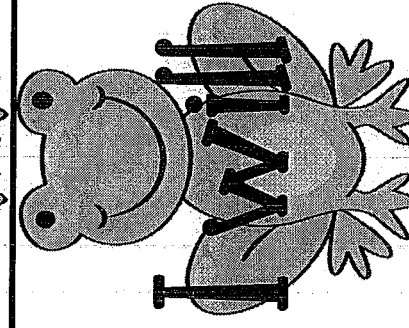
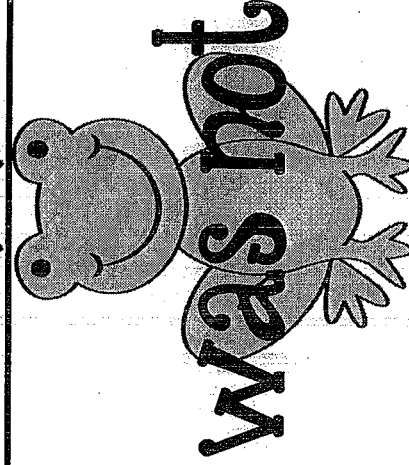
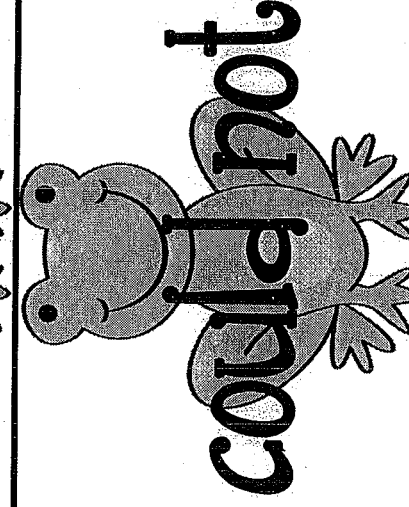
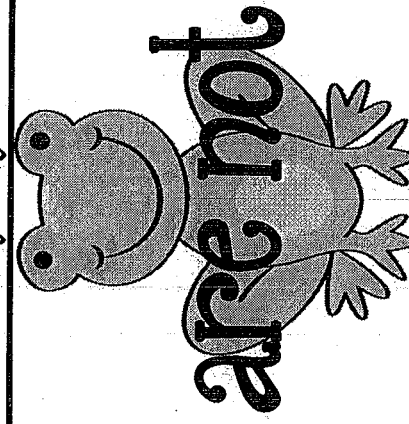
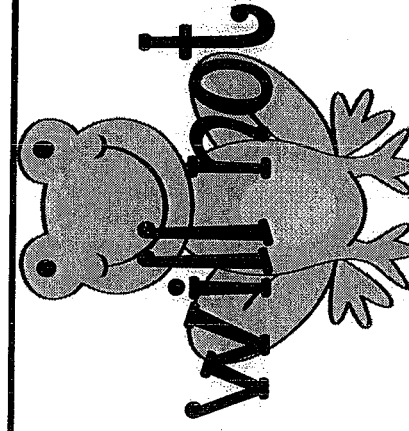
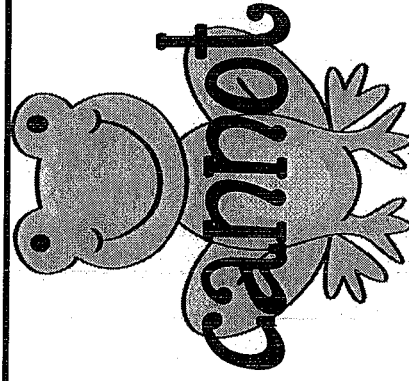
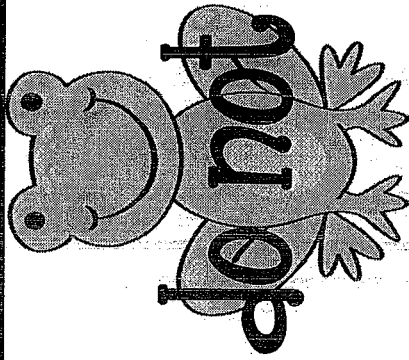
"Frog"tractions

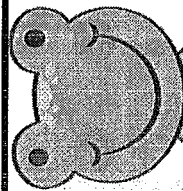

Another way to use this activity is to have students play a contraction memory game.

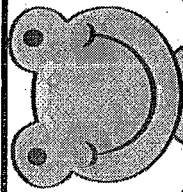

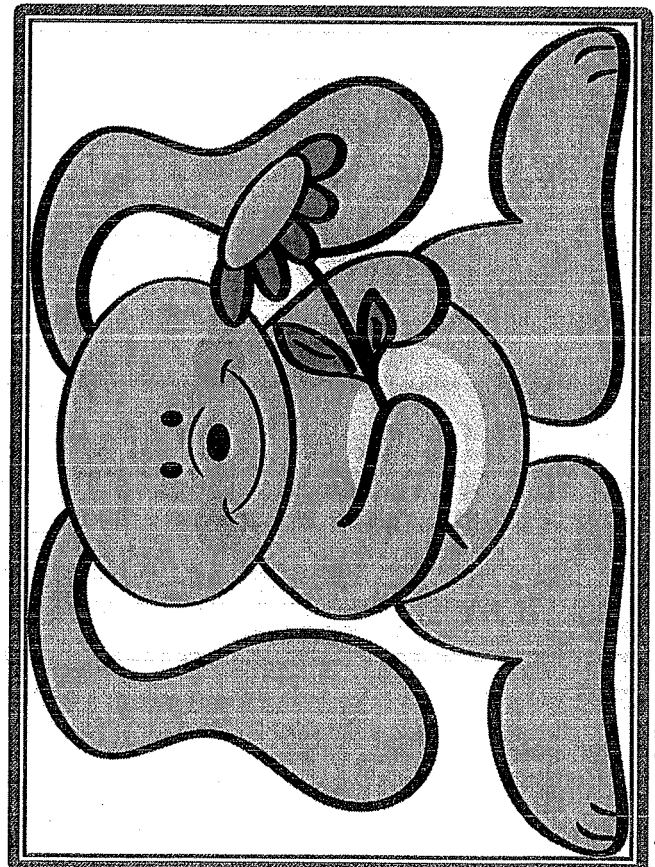
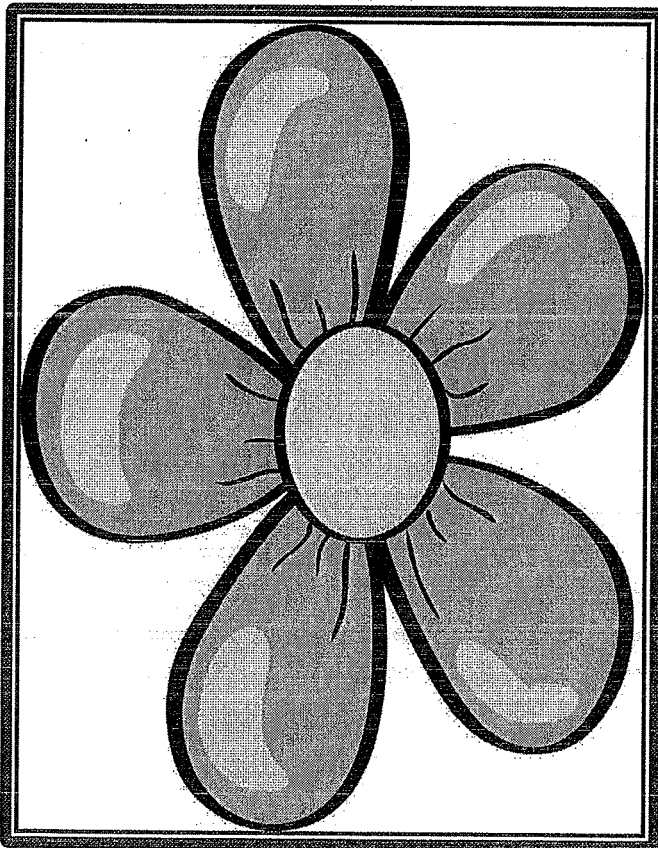
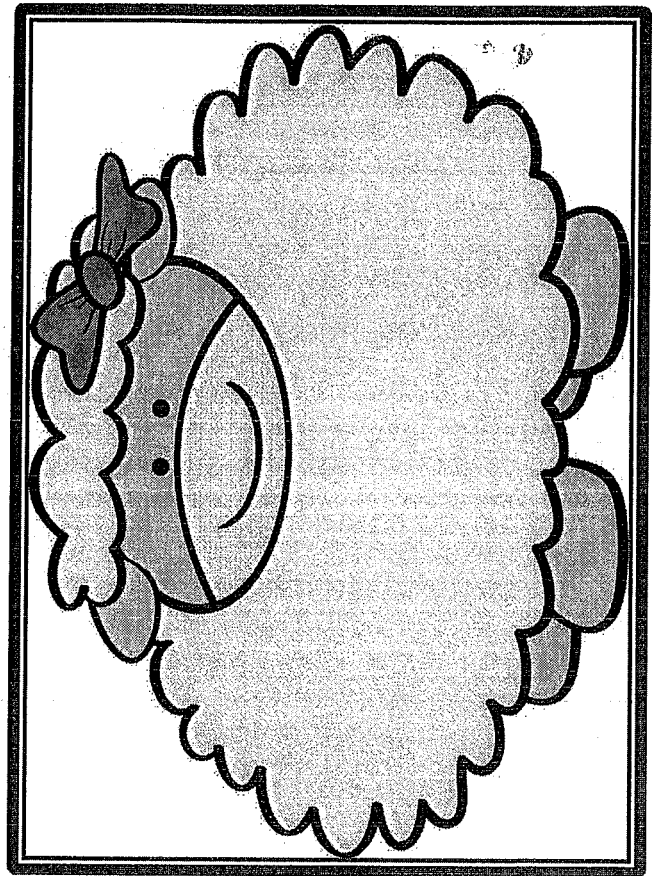
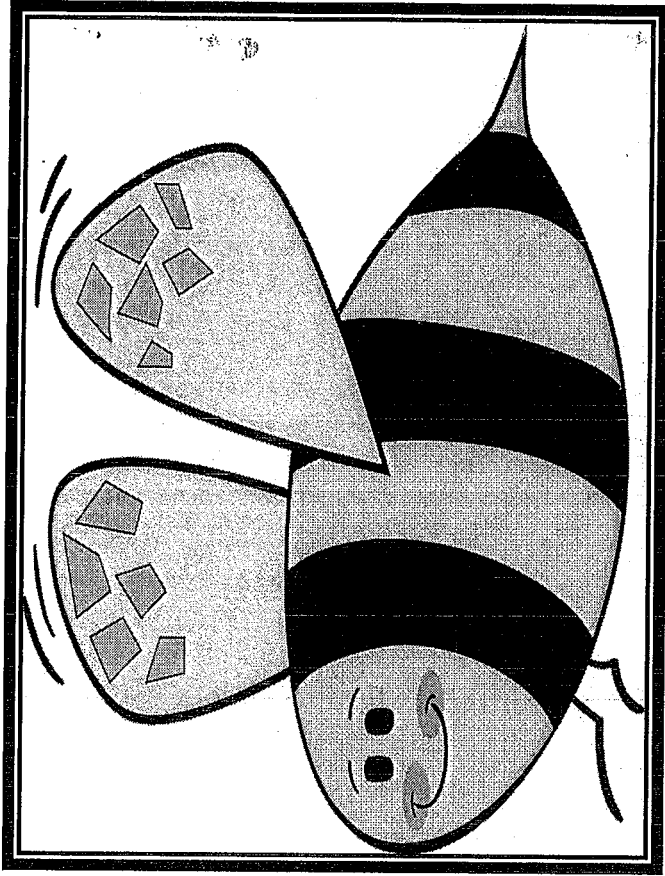
Contraction

A Vowel Team Game

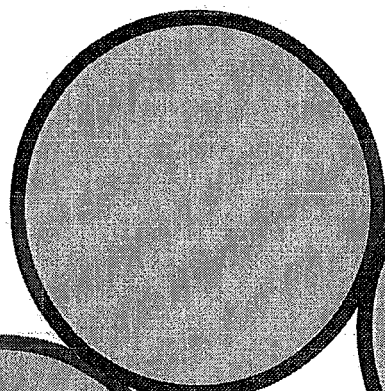
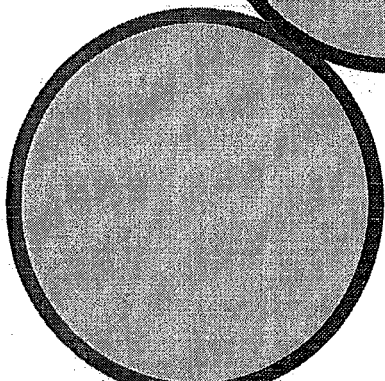
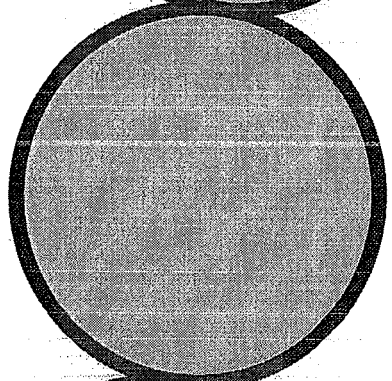
