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What is the Family ID Website and what do you need to sign up?

Family ID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for our programs, and helps us to be more administratively efficient and environmentally responsible. When you register through Family ID, the system keeps track of your information in your Family ID profile. You enter your information only once for each family member for multiple uses and multiple programs.

BEFORE YOU REGISTER:

Students must have a physical exam that was completely within the last 12 months. The physical must state that the student can participate in sports and it be signed by a physician or Nurse practitioner. This document can be uploaded to the Family ID system or a copy can be given to the nurse in your child's school.

All Students in order to be requalified need a vision and Blood pressure screen completed within the past 1 year. If a Blood Pressure or vision screen were not done in school or completed during their most recent physical your child will be asked to see a health office staff member to have a Blood pressure or vision screen completed as part of the requalification process. Nurses will communicate times and locations where students can be seen for these screenings. In addition, if your child has a medical condition that requires medication such as a rescue inhaler for asthma or and Epi Pen you will be asked to have your child's physician's office provide the order for medication as part of the requalification process.

The student must have an up to date Tetanus shot (within 10 years)

INFORMATION NEEDED TO REGISTER:

It will be helpful to have the following information handy to allow for accurate completion of your online registration.

If your child has, a medical alert and needs epi - pen, inhaler or any lifesaving medication they must provide a self - carry order signed by the physician, parent and student. This must be provided prior to being recertified.

WHERE CAN I GO TO GET A PHYSICAL?

- Call your primary care doctor – It might be hard to get in before Aug. 22nd
- Urgent Care does do physicals- Call first and find out how much they charge

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FAMILY ID REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registration opens on July 20th for Football & July 22nd for ALL Sports!!!

Parent/Guardian should register by clicking on this link:

Follow these steps: To find your program, click on the link provided by the Organization above and select the registration form under the word Programs (MAKE SURE TO REGISTER UNDER EDISON).

1. Next click on the blue Register Now button and scroll, if necessary, to the Create Account/Log In green buttons. If this is your first-time using Family ID, click Create Account. Click Log In, if you already have a Family ID account.
2. Create your secure Family ID account by entering the account owner First and Last Names (parent/guardian), E-mail address and password. Select I Agree to the Family ID Terms of Service. Click Create Account.
3. You will receive an email with a link to activate your new account. (If you don't see the email, check your E-mail filters (spam, junk, etc.).
4. Click on the link in your activation E-mail, which will log you in to FamilyID.com
5. Once in the registration form, complete the information requested. All fields with a red* are required to have an answer.
6. Click the Continue button when your form is complete.
7. Review your registration summary.
8. Click the green Submit button. After selecting 'Submit', the registration will be complete. You will receive a completion email from Family ID confirming your registration.

This does **NOT** mean you are ready to start practice. The nurse will review your information and will send you an email if you need anything more or that you are cleared to start practice.

At any time, you may login at www.familyid.com to update your information and to check your registration(s).

To view a completed registration, select the 'Registration' tab on the blue bar.
