## **Instructional Strategies:**

Creating a sense of urgency around the work is critical. We have 40 instructional days before the NYS ELA assessment and 52 instructional days before the NYS Math and Regents Testing as of today. What are the instructional plans that will support this sense of urgency?

#### Ideas:

- Hahn: Look at data to see how scholars performed the year before and see which
  questions were missed the most and work on that skill on certain days
- Valerio: Look at highly tested standards and create lessons around those standards
- Pick a day a week to focus on RACE and CUBES strategies during math intervention and WIN time
- Will discuss with grades 3-6 teachers for further suggestions
