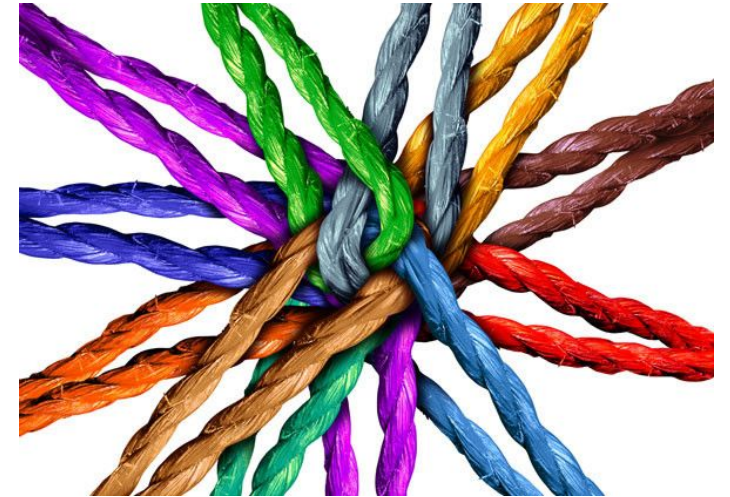


Receivership & Community Engagement (Commissioner's Reg §100.19 c(3))

- Working collaboratively with Community Engagement Team to review the progress of implementation at the school and determine next steps or revisions to the plan.
- The Community Engagement Team is charged with developing recommendations for improvement of the school and for soliciting input regarding their recommendations through public engagement.
- The Community Engagement Team will work to assess the degree to which the school's Comprehensive Education Plan or Department-approved intervention plan is being successfully implemented and provide on-going recommendations at least twice annually to school leadership.

Collective Impact

1. Common Agenda - shared vision for change, joint approach for lifting improvement
2. Shared Measurable Goals: data, results, short list of indicators, shared accountability for the lift
3. Reinforcing Activities - diverse stakeholders working together, win-win, coordinated with larger plan.

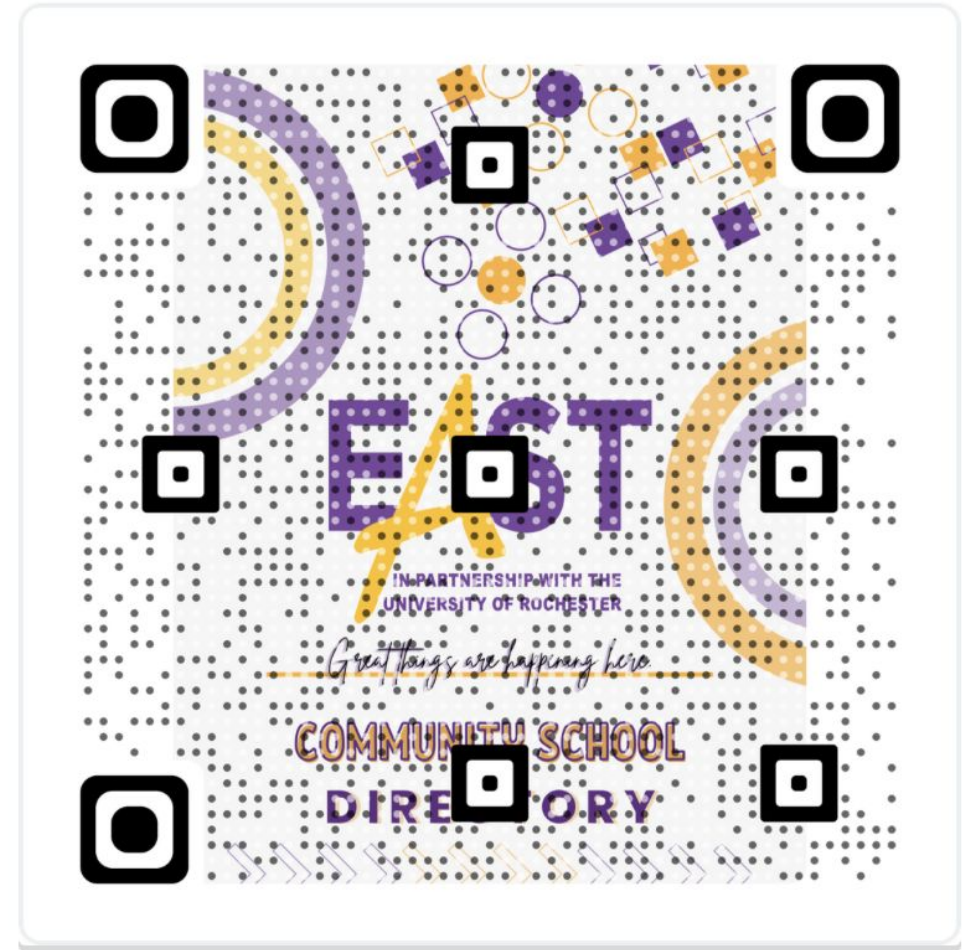
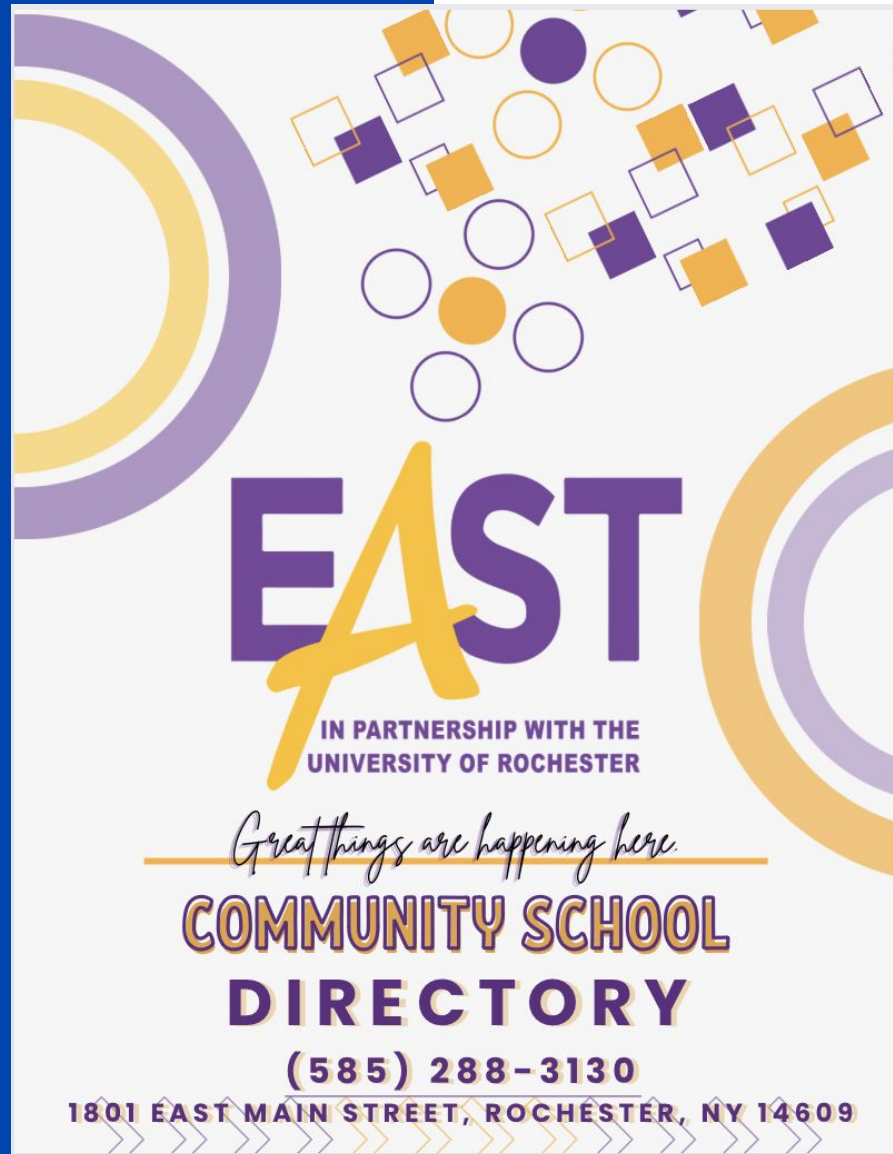
