Title 1 Plan (A. Alicea)

- Mr. Alicea provided information about this school year Title 1 process.
- The following learning activities were selected by our families during a parent's survey, Graduation Requirement, College Readiness, Career Technical Education, Mental Health, and Athletic NCAA Requirements.
- We will be offering these learning activities in person and virtual to our families.
 There is a series of school wide event such as BBQ/Orientation, Parent teacher conference/Career Fair, Black History celebration, Senior celebration, ENL cultural celebration, End of the Year FACE Event and Lower School Summer family's celebration.
- All this event will be founded by Title 1.
- The Title 1 Process
 - Must be completed as Google doc.
 - o Deadline May 31, 2023
 - Allocation
 - Lower School \$4,287

- Upper School \$9,617
- Totaling \$13,904
- o Application must be approved by the October governance council.
- With the title 1 funds we will allocate funds for the following's lines: food, bus passes, supplies, teachers, vendors, and Civil Service.
- We will be working on the final draff to submit to the schools Government Council for their approval. Once the application is approved by the GC, I will submit the application.

FACE Committees (C. Leone)

- Because we're under receivership we're required to have a community engagement team that focuses on collective action lot of this has been happening on its own and not necessarily linked to FACE
- This year we would like to link some of the school-based Committees into the FACE work.
- Here are some of the comities.
 - o Wellness Committee that focuses on health and wellness and social emotional well-being so in school you started a social emotional learning Council the recommendation from that Council will be shared with folks here from the community agencies on social emotional learning into one Collective Action Network to be updated to face My Hope Is that each Collective Action Network can actually take a lead on planning one of the activities so if there's going to be a family night on Mental Health and Wellness for families that actually the folks that are part of the committee and the collective Action Network are part of sharing that expertise with our families and community members so we'll be kind of creating a bridge between school day and out of school day between School staff and out and community staff right to be one voice one united front and supporting our Scholars and their families.
 - College Readiness focused on college readiness and college access well wouldn't it be great if they could be coordinated together and be able to support us in doing the teaching parents and families and students about the process of college access. we have multiple Community Partners in the school that can help on this committee we even have some present at this meeting tonight.
 - o Career and Workforce Development
 - o **Family Engagement and Support** we also have expertise that we're going to bring in from the children's agenda and the Children's Institute that can support this committee.
- These committees will be meeting outside of FACE meeting to plan and make recommendations to the FACE team and from there those recommendation will be sent to the Government Council.
- We will need to have committees' representation at our monthly FACE meetings.
