Dear Advanced Placement Student and Parent/Guardian:

The schedule of AP exams and locations is on the reverse side of this letter. **Please review this letter and schedule carefully.** This school year SOTA has participated in the AP digital transition pilot with the CollegeBoard. This pilot has allowed students and teachers to have access to online resources as well as implement a new exam ordering process. I wanted to thank all students for their cooperation with this process and our successful implementation of the new system.

One specific change in the digital transition that impacts seniors is the delivery of AP scores to the college or university they plan to attend for the fall of 2019. Students will have until June 15, 2019 to indicate the destination of their scores. They can indicate their choice through their "MY AP" account.

Similar to past school years, we will hold the majority of our exams at the Memorial Art Gallery. The two exceptions for this year are United States Government & Politics and Music Theory. Both exams will be held at the Visual Studies Workshop. Please note the start times for each exam. Students with test modifications will be assigned to alternate locations for their exam(s). I will communicate directly with these students for their test location.

On the attached testing schedule please note the start time of each exam. It is important that students meet at the designated meeting area and time as instructed by their teacher so that testing can start on time and stay on schedule.

Students Must Bring to Exam

- Picture ID
- Sharpened Pencils and black or blue ballpoint pens
- AP Approved calculator if required for test

Students May Not Bring:

- Books, papers, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters or compasses

Please be Aware:

- Food or drink may only be consumed during the ten minute break between parts of the exam
- Purses, cell phones, backpacks or any other personal items must be left at the designated spot at the exam site, they will not be permitted at student desks
- Cell phones must remain turned off until students are dismissed from the exam
- After the exam, students must not discuss multiple choice questions with anyone, including their AP teacher and they may not discuss free response questions with anyone until 48 hours after the exam. Students who communicate by any means will have their exam grades cancelled.
