Arrival and Dismissal:

The school day starts at 7:35 am. Please be sure that students who are being dropped off or walk do not arrive at the building before 7:30. Students are considered late after 8:10. At the end of the day, students who do not ride the bus should be picked up by 2:20 PM. Any students waiting beyond dismissal will be placed in the office for pick up.
