Received well by middle school students due to our weekly testing routine. -Encouraging lower grades to follow a weekly assessment and breaking down the time by reading during testing times. -Building stamina and test taking seriousness within the culture of building. -Transitions from 6 to 7 and Pre-K to Kindergarten are always jarring to students due to extended time on tasks. -Pushing towards presenting a task on students to perform independently, to struggle and persevere, and then regroup. -Writer's workshop dropped off this year. -K-8 ELA/Math vertical alignment meetings to go over key skills students should be developing each grade level.

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
