ILT Updates (every meeting)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Math testing – info, set-up, preparation for this week’s NYS testing • We are getting close to the persistently violent index number as more incidents are logged (we are .25 over the target so far) • Injuries from assaults are weighted differently, depending on the incidents, although fights are weighted as “0” • Weather is getting nicer, need to diffuse situations before they occur • Some incidents are from the same 2 or 3 students, so we can provide evidence to reduce the numbers • NYS Math make-ups need to be completed by next Wed (5/9), we are at risk of missing the 95% black male participants in testing due to recent absences
