- As a TIME Collaborative school, School 34 offers students 8-hour school days that include a variety of academic intervention support, as well as enrichment activities.
- Young Audience of Rochester works with students to deliver arts integration during the school day.
- Three teachers from Encompass provide students with academic intervention in addition to the classroom teachers.

Engaging Enrichment

Student's schedules include exciting enrichment electives beyond traditional Rochester City School District classes. Using student interests and best instructional practices, the program is tailored to increase students' ability to interact socially, artistically, and academically. Sample enrichment classes include the following:

Board Games — a fun, interactive way for students to learn about logic and reasoning, spatial reasoning, critical thinking and spelling. Games include chess, checkers, Boggle, Connect 4, Monopoly, and Jenga, plus many more

Boy/Girl Scouts — offers an exciting mix of focused activities that meet the interests, needs, abilities, and dreams of today's scouts

CompassLearning® — this online approach to learning combines rigorous, research-based instruction with fun, digital content and real-time, actionable data to produce greater student progress faster

Dance — provides lessons in various dance styles beyond hip-hop, including ballroom dancing and tango

First Lego/First Robotics — introduces students to real-world engineering challenges by building LEGO-based objects

Intramural Sports — engages students in various sports, such as flag football, basketball, soccer, and softball
