



## ELECTION TO WORK AGREEMENT 2017-18 SCHOOL YEAR

I, <u>(Employee ID)</u>, am electing to work at Enrico Fermi School #17. I am signing this Election-to-Work Agreement to indicate that I understand and agree to the terms and conditions of my employment as outlined in the detailed Election-to-Work Agreement.

# 1) Professional Day and Responsibilities

- Instructional Day 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Grades K-8
  9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Pre Kindergarten 3 & 4
  8:45 a.m. Staff Reporting Time
- Faculty Meetings 7:45 a.m. 8:45 a.m., up to twice per month (voluntary participation)
- Collaborative Planning Time 45 minutes, twice per week within contractual day
- Length of Work Day 7 hours 30 minutes for all classroom teachers in grades K-8\*
  - -- 6 hours 30 minutes for PreK teachers, special subject, & support staff
    \*see Job-Sharing Details & Possibilities outlined in Section 16 of EWA

## 2) Professional Development

- Up to 30 hours of school-based professional development during summer months to be compensated at contractual rate; dates will be determined prior to July 1, 2017
- Up to 36 hours of school-based professional development during the school year; preliminary dates will be determined prior to September 1, 2017. Hours may be applied toward the district's PD incentive.
- Job-embedded coaching and participation in all collaborative team meetings, minimum of two x 45 min. sessions per week for all classroom teachers
- Educational Support Staff collaborative meetings to support data-based decision making, minimum of once monthly

  - All curricula will be aligned to CCLS and meet or exceed the rigor of RCSD expectations.
