**Hot Topics/Current
Issues**

- Mayoral address of the city will be held at School 17 on 4/23. No board members will be present.
- Disagreement between mayor and school board over budget and allocation of funding was discussed
 - Mayor sent document to board of regents saying the school board has to allocate x amount of money to specific programs in specific school – outcome TBD
- Leone shared upcoming dates of board meeting hearings concerning the budget: April 11th, 16th, 23rd – unsure if speakers are allowed
- \$375,000 allocated back for ELT after first projection. Not enough money to fund for the entire year – only about 12 weeks’ worth of funding
- Advocating for an earlier start time for next year. 7:45 – 2:30, with ELT (if get enough funding for it) then 3:30 end time.
- DTSD
 - quarterly report due at end of month for receivership quarter three
 - six instances kept us out of good standing
 - our school has done own investigation on racial codes for our students. Students have incorrect codes due to registration errors. So far 43 student codes have been corrected.
- Safety concerns with a student with special needs. District is returning him to the building due to improper documentation. Due to his dangerous/harmful/overly sexualized behaviors to students and staff, measures are being taken by School 17 staff, as well as outside agencies, in attempt to properly place this student outside of this building.
