## **CLASS OF 2020 SENIOR TRIP TO CEDAR POINT**

The senior class has the opportunity to go to Cedar Point Amusement Park in Sandusky, Ohio for their senior trip! The cost for the trip is \$250.00. Please note that grades, attendance, and behavior are all factors in whether or not your child may attend the trip. The itinerary is as follows:

## FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2019:

9:00 AM Leave SOTA - coach bus trip to Cedar Point

1:00 PM Lunch - Erie, PA - students may purchase, bring lunch, or request a bag lunch

4:00 PM Arrival - Cedar Point Express Hotel 5:00 PM Entrance into the park – students pay

12:00 AM Park closes

## SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2019:

9:00 AM Breakfast – cost included

10:00 AM Entrance into the park – students pay for lunch

5:00 PM Pizza party at the hotel – cost included

6:30 PM Return to the park

12:00 AM Park closes

#### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2019:**

7:00 AM Wake-up, pack, and breakfast – cost included

8:00 AM Board the bus 11:00 AM Lunch – students pay

1:30 PM Return to SOTA – parents/guardians pick-up students from SOTA parking lot

## \$250.00 COST INCLUDES: FULL PAYMENT IS DUE SEPTEMBER 13, 2019

Entrance into the park on Friday night and early on Saturday morning Hotel accommodations for Friday and Saturday night – 4 students per room Continental breakfast on Saturday and Sunday; dinner on Saturday night Charter bus transportation

### **NOTES**

- We will travel to and from Cedar Point by bus.
- Students will stay at Cedar Point's Express Hotel for the two nights.
- Students may bring snacks, and unopened beverages/sodas for the bus ride and hotel.
- Luggage must arrive at SOTA by 2:30 PM on Thursday, October 3, 2019 for scanning.
- Students and carry-on luggage will be scanned prior to boarding the bus.
- Students sign a contract when they turn-in their first payment.
- Students will only need money for food for when they are in the park, and for on the bus rides.
- Students are expected to adhere to all SOTA, RCSD, and park rules/regulations.
- If a student does not adhere to the rules, their parent/guardian will be contacted, and they will be expected to pick up their child, or arrange for transportation home from the park.
- Students will receive a consequence upon returning to school if they do not adhere to all the rules and expectations.

SOTA's seniors really look forward to attending the annual trip to Cedar Point. It's really fun, offers a perfect opportunity to make new friends, and create lasting memories.
