**Safety of Everyone:**

- Masks must be worn at all times over your nose, mouth and chin. The only time the mask should be removed is when sitting and eating. Masks must be worn on the bus.
- Carry your ID at all times and wear it around your neck. This identifies you as a SOTA student, allows you on the bus, if you are late– it is used to sign you in and it designates which lunch period you have. Our hope is to update the ID pictures.
- Arrival and Dismissal: the breakfast door and front door open at 8 AM. Once you arrive, please come in the building. In the afternoon, once you exit the building, please get on your bus. If you are staying afterschool with a coach or teacher, please remain in the building and go to their location- do not exit the building and reenter (unless you talk to an adult).
- What should your child do if they have a conflict with another student? Encourage your child to see their counselor or administrator. We have staff that can facilitate mediations and assist with strategies and problem solving.
