School of the Arts bell times are 8:30 AM - 3:30 PM with the building opening at 8:05 AM for breakfast and scanning. Students who walk or get a ride to school should plan on arriving as close to 8:05 AM as possible in order to be in class by 8:30 AM.

Please note: there is no student supervision after 3:30 PM. All students need must exit the building by 3:30 PM unless they are staying for an approved after school activity under the supervision of a faculty member. ## THE NUTS AND BOLTS OF 2023-2024

- Schedules Student schedules will be mailed home the week of August 28 and uploaded to PowerSchool. A fresh copy will be given to students upon arrival to school in 1<sup>st</sup> period.
- Attendance Parents and guardians have the obligation to inform the school if their child will be absent by phone prior to the absence, or as soon as they are aware of the intended absence. Written notification is required upon the student's return to school. Contact information for specific grade levels is available at <u>Attendance Offices</u>. The switchboard is open and available for calls between 8 AM – 3:30 PM.
- **Chromebooks** Students are issued a Chromebook and charger. It is the expectation that this will be used for all coursework. We encourage you to leave your personal laptops, iPads, etc. at home. Please bring your charged chrome book to school every day.
- **Personal Electronic Devices** To put the focus on academic achievement, minimize schooltime distractions, and encourage positive communication, use of cell phones, smart watches, headphones, etc. are prohibited throughout the school day. At the beginning of the school year, every student will be given a personal **Yondr Pouch**. It is each student's responsibility to

bring their pouch with them to school every day. If a student forgets or loses their pouch, they will surrender their phone for the day. Phones will be returned in the foyer at dismissal.

- Breakfast Students who want breakfast will report to the cafeteria upon arrival. Breakfast • ends promptly at 8:25 AM to support a timely start of the school day.
- **Scanning** Rochester City School District policy requires that all students are subject to random metal detection scanning. Anyone refusing to be scanned or found in the possession of any prohibited items may be referred for long-term suspension. Some of these items are, but not limited to: glass bottles, colognes/ perfumes, permanent or Sharpie Markers, scissors and lighters/matches or weapons of any kind. Drugs or any type of alcohol, controlled substances and/or paraphernalia are also prohibited. All items that may be deemed inappropriate are at the discretion of the Administration. Parents may retrieve confiscated items from grade-level administrator.
- Athletics Students interested in playing modified, JV or Varsity sports should visit our website at ٠ Athletics.
- Outside Food Ordering SOTA does not allow food delivery during the school day. Breakfast • and lunch are provided daily at no cost to students. Please plan your meals accordingly.

- Transportation and Student IDs Students will receive a temporary pass in the mail prior to the • start of school. Temporary passes are good until they receive a permanent picture ID from SOTA.
