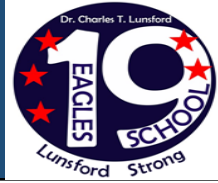

4:10-4:55	45	<p>Agenda:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Receivership Quarterly Report - share draft <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Moniek reviewed the draft report with the team and SBPT gave feedback and had an opportunity to ask questions about report data/contents. ○ Team reflected on some of the data around academic growth and attendance ● Summer School <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 150 students ○ July 11th - August 5th ○ Survey staff for interest - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ in order to offer summer school, we need to have enough teachers to implement it. ▪ Several teachers spoke positively about their experience doing a project-based summer school last year. Felt students and teachers enjoyed the program. ▪ It could be either a half day program or a full day program. A full day program might attract more parent interest.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ We need to survey staff to gauge interest in teaching and willingness to teach half day versus full day. However, several suggested that we wait until we know a little more about what is happening next year with the merger. ● IXL tutoring - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 2 sessions afterschool on Tuesdays, one in-person session and one online session (total of 2 hours, one hour per session). ○ The tutoring will last 14 weeks. We may offer two 7 week sessions so that more students can receive tutoring. ○ We have 22 5th and 6th grade students we are trying to target. The opportunity will be offered to all. How many students we can service will depend upon how many teacher tutors we recruit. ○ teachers will be working in very small groups (max 4) or one to one ● Orders update - We have ordered a number of items that staff requested. We need to plan for use and distribution (headphones, etc.) ● PD Calendar - share <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Shared calendar for feedback. Jamie shared the results of the staff survey of interest around possible book titles. ● Book Circle Updates - Jamie will send out a poll. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Jamie will send an update ● Other
