PUBLIC USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The school buildings and grounds are maintained for the education and recreation of the school children of the district, and no use shall be made of the buildings or grounds which would interfere or disrupt their most effective use for the benefit of the school children. All uses of school buildings and grounds shall be consistent with Section 414 of the Education Law.

Such use may take place during school hours only if, in the opinion of the Superintendent (or their designee), the use will not be disruptive of normal school operations. Both during and after school hours, all such use should pertain to the general welfare of the school and/or community, in compliance with the Education Law. Any such use, however, shall not be deemed an endorsement of the activity or purpose for which the facilities are used.
