

BOARD OF EDUCATION GOALS AND METRICS

The Board of Education, as a legally constituted body of elected representatives, bears the responsibility of setting policy for the district. The Board acts in accordance with the authority and responsibility vested in it by federal and state laws, rules, and regulations on behalf of the district's citizens.

In order to ensure that its educational programs provide all students with high-quality education, the Board will:

1. Work closely with the community to ensure that Board actions and performance take into consideration the concerns and aspirations of the community.
2. Identify the educational and technological needs of the community and industry, to transform such needs into programs aimed at stimulating students and preparing them for future careers, and regularly assess the quality and equity of the District.
3. Employ and evaluate a Superintendent of Schools in accordance with policy 0320, capable of ensuring that school personnel carry out the policies of the Board.
4. Provide leadership in order that the Board's goals can be effectively carried out. Board action should be confined to policy-making, planning, and appraisal with the Board delegating authority to the Superintendent for the implementation of policies.
5. Evaluate progress toward the achievement of District long- and short-term goals and ensure that Board policies and resources effectively support the District's vision.
6. Provide appropriate staff and Board training opportunities.
7. Fulfill governance responsibilities as required by state and federal law.

The Rochester City School District Mission and Vision Statements drive the Board of Education's goals and are outlined in the Educational Philosophy policy (0000). Given that these goals will vary somewhat from year to year, the Board goals shall be annexed to this policy as Exhibit 1 (2000-E1). These annual goals drive the Superintendent's Goals and Objectives (3000).
