NON-RESIDENT TUITION

The Board of Education will establish tuition rates for non-resident students each year. Non-resident is defined as a student who resides outside of the City of Rochester. There are three primary types of non-resident students. The non-resident students in the Youth and Justice programs that receive daily tutoring, the non-resident English Language Learners and the foster care students. Rates charged for Tutoring and ELL are calculated based upon the Rochester City School District's cost structure. The Foster Care rates are calculated per the formula provided by the New York State Educational Department.

The administration shall advance a resolution setting the non-resident tuition rates as soon as practicable after the administration is notified of those rates by the New York State Education Department.
