

SUPPORT SERVICES GOALS

Support services, which include safety and maintenance programs, transportation, food services, insurance management and office services, are essential to the successful functioning of the school district. Education is the District's central function, and all support services shall be provided, guided, and evaluated by this function.

In order to provide services that are truly supportive of the educational program, the Board of Education establishes these goals for the District:

1. Provide a physical environment for teaching and learning that is safe, clean and engaging for students, staff and parents.
2. Provide efficient, reliable transportation, and nutritious and inviting student meals.
3. Provide clean and adequate facilities at all District schools and offices with regular maintenance and upgrades.
4. Provide social/emotional learning experiences to help all students develop healthy social habits and mindsets.
5. Provide effective counseling and/or mental health support for students who require it.
6. Coordinate and collaborate through community partnerships related to student support and physical/mental health.
7. Increase graduation rate through efforts of school counselors who know students and their desired pathways and guide them to successful graduation and college/career choices.
