NON-RESIDENT TUITION

The Board of Education will establish a tuition rate for non-resident students each year, using the formulae provided by the State Education Department in calculating the tuition rates. For school attendance by a non-resident child for a period longer than 90 calendar days, tuition is payable in advance for each succeeding 30 calendar days, or on a prorated basis.
