<u>Reading</u>: Read decodable text that incorporates the letter-sound correspondences taught with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension.

<u>Writing</u>: Write words with the lettersound correspondences taught during skills lessons.

<u>Math</u>: Make a 10 to add and subtract within 100. Decompose to subtract and apply this concept to one-step word problems.

<u>Social Studies/Science</u>: Citizenship; rules and laws, three types of communities.
