Dignity for All Students Act REPORTING FORM

New York State's Dignity for All Students Act (The Dignity Act) seeks to provide the State's public elementary and secondary school students with a **safe and supportive** environment free from discrimination, intimidation, taunting, harassment, and bullying on school property, a school bus and/or at a school function. The Dignity Act also amended Section 801-a of New York State Education Law regarding instruction in *civility*, *citizenship*, and *character education* by expanding the concepts of *tolerance*, *respect for others* and *dignity* to include: an *awareness* and *sensitivity* in the relations of people, including but not limited to, *actual or perceived* <u>races</u>, weights, national origins, ethnic groups, religious practices, mental or physical abilities, sexual orientations, gender identity, and sexes.
