Inspire reading by filling your home

with reading materials



One of the most effective ways to get your child to read is to surround him or her with a wide variety of reading material. In addition to filling your home with books, magazines and newspapers:

Let your child own some books. It's great to check out books from the library. But owning a few books can foster a sense of pride about reading in your child. You can find great deals on used books at library fundraisers, yard sales and thrift stores.
