Homework Policy & Home Projects



3rd graders are expected to average a total of 30 minutes of homework each night. They may have math, reading, &/or spelling. On Fridays your child will be given a reading log to complete as well as written assignments.

Homework is to be completed each night and your child will get a sticker for that day. At the end of the month there will be rewards for students who have handed in their homework. Homework is never used as a punishment. It is an extension of the day's lessons and practice on skills your child has learned.

During the course of each 10-week term, students will have a home project to work on. The project will be related to skills and content in the social studies curriculum, and will be factored into your child's social studies grade for that marking period. There will be ample time provided for you to work with your child and guide their completion of the project.

A book project/report will also be assigned each marking period. Children may borrow a book from the school library to complete the project. More detailed information will follow.
