Dear World of Inquiry Families,

The school year has come to an end and we begin to prepare for next year. Without question, we have faced many challenges not seen or experienced before in education. That said, we have persevered through it this school year together as CREW. We made great strides to work on the culture and climate of the school. We met the expectations in some areas, but we continue to work to improve upon others. As we prepare for next year, we also look to improve our academic performance and our attendance rate. To do so we must all be reminded of our commitments to one another as a World of Inquiry School community; as a CREW to improve upon the challenges ahead of us. Being back to school in person at the start of the 2021-2022 school year, we suspended the uniform requirement at World of Inquiry due to a number of factors. Families were challenged to find vendors to order uniforms and vendors were challenged to fulfill orders given the pivot from virtual learning to in-person learning. As a school community we deemed it more important to have our scholars back together and in school after two years than worry about how to meet the uniform requirement. The elementary and secondary crew wear and uniform policies are enclosed. Going forward ALL scholars, grades K-12 must adhere to the school dress code and the uniform policy. Fastlane and Stitchworks will be our vendors for uniforms. Secondary students (grades 7-12) will need to order their uniforms from our two vendors. elementary students may wear crew wear. I encourage families to place their uniforms orders early and not wait until late August. We will have a limited supply of donated uniforms in our clothes closet for those who request it.

SHIRTS:

Solid Polo (short or long sleeve) **Logo is not required Colors:** light blue, navy blue, white, gray, black Can be purchased at any store of your choosing.

PANTS, SHORTS, SKIRTS & SKORTS/JUMPERS: No Denim Colors: Solid

khaki (tan), black, gray, navy blue Can be purchased at any store.

- > Pants no cuts, rips, or bleached pants. Pants must be worn at waist level.
- > Shorts, Skirts & Skorts must be no higher than 2 inches above the knee and must reach to the edge of the fingertips.

Note: On days students go to P.E. students can choose to wear navy or black track or sweatpants with shorts underneath.

FLEECES, CARDIGANS, SWEATER VESTS, SWEATSHIRTS:

Logo is not required

Colors: light blue, navy blue, white, gray, black.

Sweatshirts should be <u>plain</u> with no patterns, writing or commercial emblems.

Please be advised that in addition to the WOIS Uniform Policy, all students are expected to follow RCSD Student Dress Code as noted below.

5300.25 STUDENT DRESS CODE

All students, from pre-kindergarten through 12th grade and adult education students, are expected to give proper attention to personal cleanliness and to dress appropriately (and age-appropriately) for school and school functions. The dress code applies at any time that students are on District property, including the school buildings and Central Office, and whenever they are attending any school function, wherever located. Students and their parents have the primary responsibility for acceptable student dress and appearance. Teachers and all other school personnel should exemplify and reinforce acceptable student dress and help students develop an understanding of appropriate appearance in the school setting, which is the workplace where the student is engaged in the vocation of education.

A student's dress, grooming and appearance, including hair style/color, jewelry, make-up, and nails, shall: Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.

- Recognize that stocking caps, "doo rags," bandanas and hats (other than hats or scarves mandated by verifiable religious requirements or verifiable medical reasons); unbuttoned dress shirts or sport shirts; and extremely brief garments such as men's "muscle shirts," women's tube tops, net tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, plunging necklines (front and/or back) and see-through garments are not appropriate and not permitted. For school purposes, exposure of male or female navels or gluteal areas; bare chests; or cleavage are not appropriate and not permitted.
- · Ensure that underwear is completely covered with outer clothing, and that pants or slacks are cinched with a belt of appropriate size for the student's waist.
- \cdot Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed. \cdot Not include the wearing of hats in the classroom, study halls, assembly rooms, cafeterias, or internal hallways except for a medical or religious purpose.
- · Not include items that are vulgar, obscene, libelous, or denigrate others on account of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, gender, disability, or sexual orientation. Not promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs and/or encourage other illegal or violent activities.



WOIS DRESS CODE AND UNIFORM POLICY FOR GRADES 7-12 For 2022-2023

SHIRTS:

Solid Polo (short or long sleeve):

- · Colors: light blue (grades 7-8) or navy blue (grades 9-12)
- · Polos must have school logo stitched on the front
- · Polos are available for purchase, logo included

Solid Button-Up Shirt (uniform shirt from previous years):

- · Color: Oxford solid light blue button-ups (grades 7-12)
- · Button-ups must have school logo stitched on the front
- · Ties are optional

Crew & College Wear Fridays: A<u>ll students in grades 7-12 are permitted to wear Crew Wear or College shirts on Fridays ONLY</u>. Crew wear includes WOIS, Griffin Athletics, Crew and Griffin shirts. College wear includes t-shirts, fleeces, or polos that promote any college or university. College sweatpants and track pants are not permitted. Hooded sweatshirts are not permitted.

PANTS, JOGGERS, JEGGINGS*, SHORTS, SKIRTS & SKORTS: Pants, Joggers,

Jeggings*, **Shorts**, **Skirts & Skorts** can be purchased at any store as long as they meet the following requirements:

- · Colors: Solid khaki (tan), black, or navy blue
- · No cuts, rips, or bleached pants
- · Pants must be worn at waist level
- · No jeans or denim of any kind
- · No yoga pants or spandex of any kind

Jeggings* are a form of leggings designed to resemble denim jeans but are NOT denim material. Jeggings are stretchy pants that are typically thicker material than traditional leggings or yoga pants. Unlike other leggings and yoga pants, jeggings may have faux pockets, belt loops, or buttons, etc.

Shorts, Skirts & Skorts must be **no higher than 2 inches** above the knee and must reach to the edge of the fingertips.

Sweatpants are not allowed for daily wear. Mesh shorts or basketball shorts are not acceptable.

FLEECES, CARDIGANS, SWEATER VESTS AND BLAZERS:

- · Students are permitted to wear any of the following colors: light blue, navy blue, white, gray, or black. All fleeces, cardigans, and sweater vests must have school logo stitched on the front.
- · **Hoodies are prohibited** for daily wear including Griffin Athletics and WOIS Crew Wear (Hoodies may be worn to and from school during the winter months if students do not have access to a coat; however, hoodies **MUST** remain in lockers during instructional hours).
