Checking Scholars' Grades and Attendance

There are two ways to virtually check your scholar's grades, assignments, and attendance: the PowerSchool Parent Portal and Google Classroom. Both have pros and cons. PowerSchool houses "official" information, but grades may only be updated every two weeks. Google Classroom gives a good snapshot, but there's one link for each of your scholar's classes.
