COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility for 12+

Last week the FDA authorized and the CDC endorsed the safety and effectiveness of the COVID-19 vaccine for those age 12 and older. Your scholar can receive their COVID-19 vaccine for free, and you can check for distributing locations here: https://covid19vaccine.health.ny.gov/. East's on-site UR Health Clinic will begin offering COVID-19 vaccines for scholars age 12 and older on Wednesday, May 26th. Scholars need parental consent to receive the vaccine. You can schedule an appointment by calling (585) 435-2332.

FACE and Family Learning Activity — 5/20


