CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT PLAN:

Rules

1. Be respectful: Use professional language, Level I voice, Follow adult directions, wait for turn to talk.
2. Be responsible: Turn off/Silence ALL electronic devices, follow class routines and directions, Clean up space, Cooperate/collaborate/Share ideas, Be prepared, Actively ignore disruptions.
3. Be safe: Keep hands and feet to self, Keep food and drinks closed or in your backpack, Walk at all times, Provide assistance to others.

Consequences

Throughout the school year, we will review our classroom expectations for a reminder. The following is a list of consequences that will be used, should a misunderstanding arise:

1. Reminder of the rule/Verbal warning.
2. Student-Teacher conference/Discussion with me.
3. Lunch/After-school detention.
4. Call home to parent(s)/guardian(s).
5. Discipline Referral.

**** For serious violations of the rules, Mr. Yoboue has the right to bypass the sequence of consequences****

Rewards

I will use the LEADER Habits Of Work (HOW) for rewards:

L: Listen Emphatically ~Sit Up ~Make Eye Contact ~Listen Sincerely

~Seek to Understand, *then* to be understood

E: Exhibit Integrity ~Complete Own Work ~Prioritize *academics *achievement *attendance

~Make positive choices ~Be honest

A: Attend Daily ~Come to class ~Come on time ~Stay present of mind ~Leave on time

D: Dedicated Learner ~Complete all work with quality ~Provide support to peers

~Embrace the Growth Mindset ~Set Goals and work to achieve them

E: Embrace Change ~Respect Diversity ~Work Collaboratively ~Be creative ~Find opportunities to grow

R: Respect All ~Have a win-win attitude ~Value others' opinions ~Value others' ideas ~Build up your peers

After 100 HOW points, you will be rewarded with free homework pass, 5 points toward next quiz/test or something else.

MATERIALS:

- ❖ A big spiral notebook or binder to hold class notes and homework.
- ❖ A folder with pockets to hold worksheets, quizzes and tests.
- ❖ An assignment pad, PENS AND PENCILS!!! A textbook, assigned by teacher.
- ❖ A **French** dictionary. This is optional but it will be useful to you during the year!!!

ATTENDANCE:

- ❖ The teacher will have a seating chart that may change depending on the task of the day. Students will be notified at the beginning of class, before the Warm-Up assignment.

TARDY POLICY:

- ❖ If you are late without a pass when the second bell rings, you will serve a lunch or after-school detention. Being late on multiple occurrences will result in a call to the parent(s)/guardian(s) and/or discipline referral.

ENTRANCE TO THE CLASSROOM:

- ❖ When entering, students will greet the teacher in French, sit down, and silently begin their Warm-Up assignment.

CLASS DISMISSAL POLICY:

- ❖ The teacher, NOT the bell, will dismiss students. Students will not be allowed to stand at the door before being instructed by the teacher. The teacher will not allow students to leave the classroom until their desk area is clean .

BATHROOM/WATER FOUNTAIN POLICY:

- ❖ Students will not be allowed to leave the classroom unless under extreme circumstances.

TESTS AND QUIZZES:

- ❖ Tests and quizzes are based on homework and class work. They involve writing as well as reading, listening and speaking, along with culture.
- ❖ You will probably have one test/quiz per week. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING UP ANY MISSED TEST. IF YOU DO MISS A TEST, YOU MUST COME AND TALK TO ME TO DISCUSS A MUTUAL TIME TO MAKE IT UP.**
- ❖ There may be several projects during the year, and they will count as a test grade.

MAKE UP POLICY:

- ❖ I will post make-up assignments on my East High School website: <http://www.rcsdk12.org//Domain/3786>.
- ❖ You are responsible for making up any missed assignments within a reasonable time period determined by Mr. Yoboue.
- ❖ Make up does not occur during class time.
- ❖ You must make arrangements to see me during your lunch or after school to complete any missed assignments or activities.
- ❖ If you have excessive absences in a marking period, you will automatically fail, regardless of your actual grade, unless you make arrangements to stay after school or during your lunch period to make up missed classes.

GRADING:

- ❖ Tests/Quizzes: 50%
- ❖ Class work: 20%
- ❖ Homework: 20%
- ❖ Participation/Behavior: 10%
- ❖ Participation means: Speaking in **French**, going to the board, raising your hand to volunteer answers, reading in **French**, participating in group activities, etc.

I understand that these rules are very important to my success in this class, and I will follow them daily. I also realize that if I break a rule I will be penalized (loss of points, after-school detention, referral, parent-teacher conference, and so forth.)
