

Body Paragraph I Organizer (Claim/Rule #1)

Claim Bud uses "RTLB" # <u>83</u> to help him thrive/survive (1 sentence, possibly 2)	<p>Bud uses rule # 83 to help him survive. Rule # 83 states, "If an adult tells you not to worry, and you weren't worried before, you better hurry up and start 'cause you're already running late."</p>
Context = transition <i>Background: Tell when Bud uses this rule</i> (2 sentences) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use words like after, before, during, and when to tell your reader what is happening in the story. <p>HINT: who, what, when, where, why</p>	<p>Bud uses this rule to survive when he looked in retrospect and realized what his mom meant when she said, "When one door closes, another door opens."</p>
