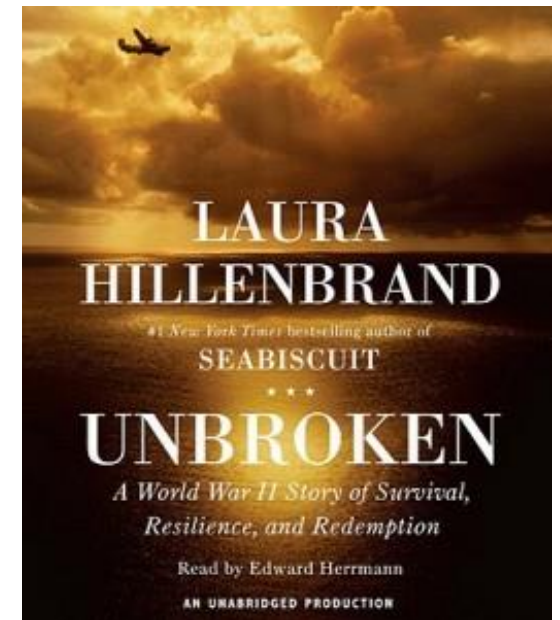
Re-read the following lines from the preface:

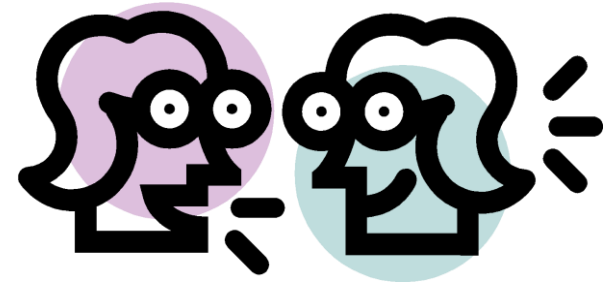
- Where and when is this story taking place? Explain this using historical background. Be sure to use at least two (2) pieces of evidence from the novel to support your thinking.
