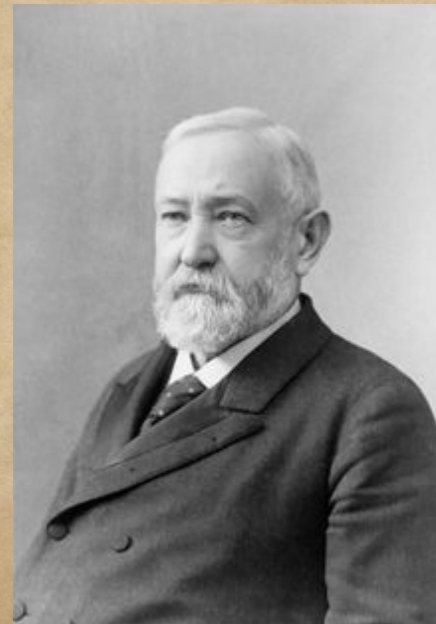
Frederick Douglass was born in Tuckahoe. He don't know much about himself. He don't know his birthday and age. This make things really sad.

Frederick Douglass say "I first met her at the door-a woman of the kindest heart and finest feelings." she was sweet but that didn't last for long she became a demon woman.

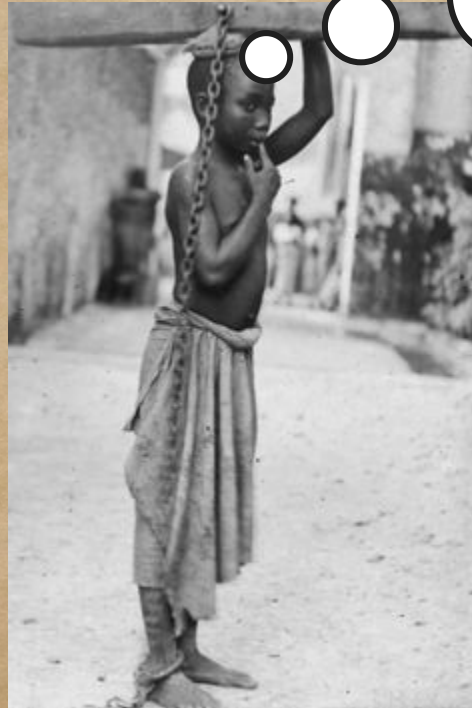




she was sweet but that didn't last for long she became a demon woman but then she wanted to teach Douglass how to learn his ABC's but Mr.Auld forbid to do it further.

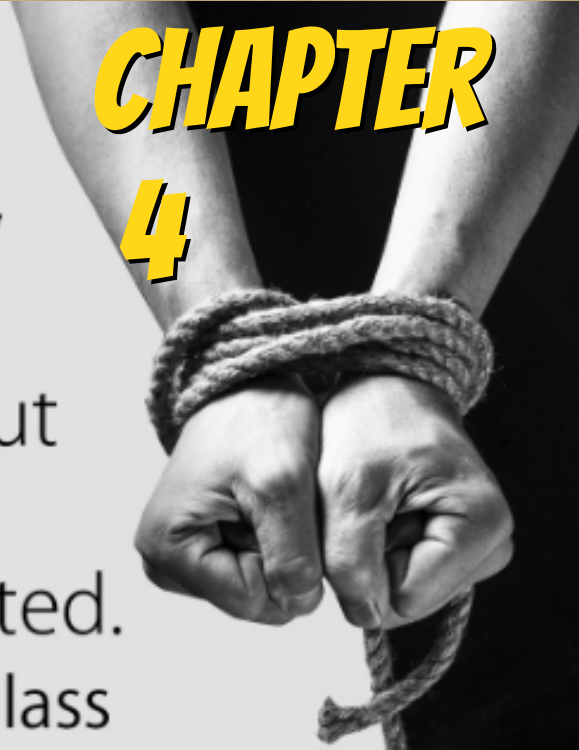
He moved to a man with Mr. Covey he was hard, he whip them everyday of the hour. He was always their like an snake they worked no matter their conditions and how the weather is.

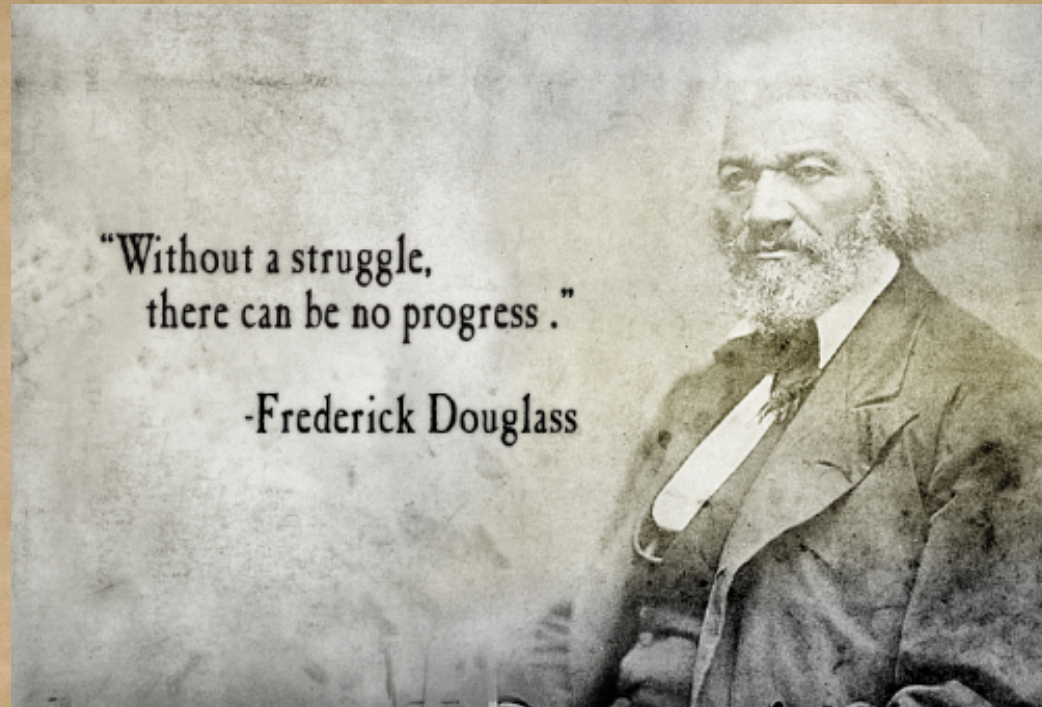


Frederick Douglass can't take no more

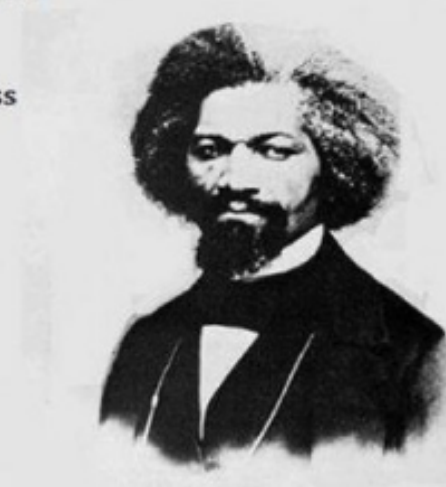
Mr. Covey said "He asked me if i
