

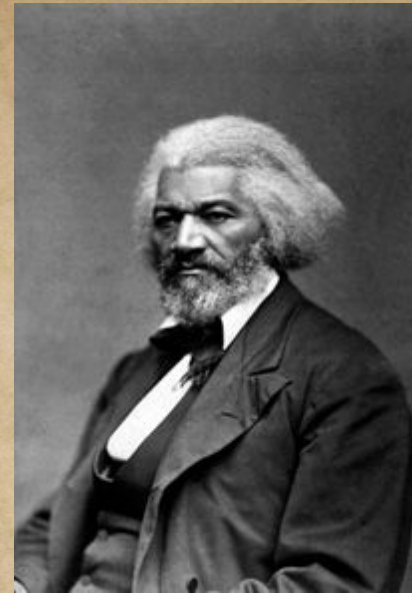
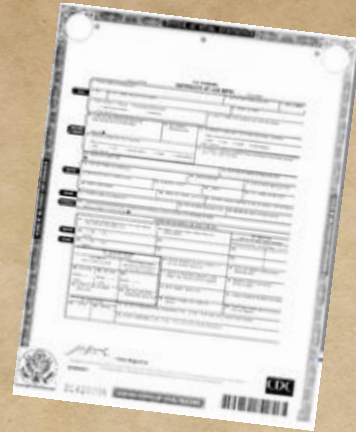
The steps of being enslaved

Hi my name is Zameeria Bryant (on the top) and my name is Manaya Jessie (on the bottom) We are both thirteen years old and go to East High school

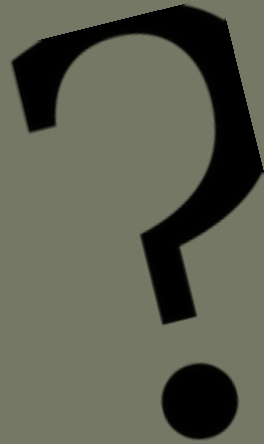




Frederick Douglass has no accurate knowledge of his age, birthday or parents. Also for enslaved people to get there needs they go to a farm that provides them.

never having seen any type of authentic knowledge of it."



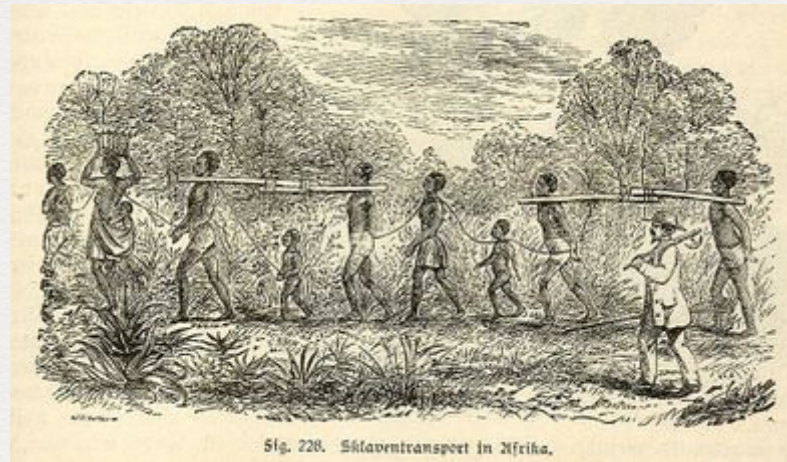

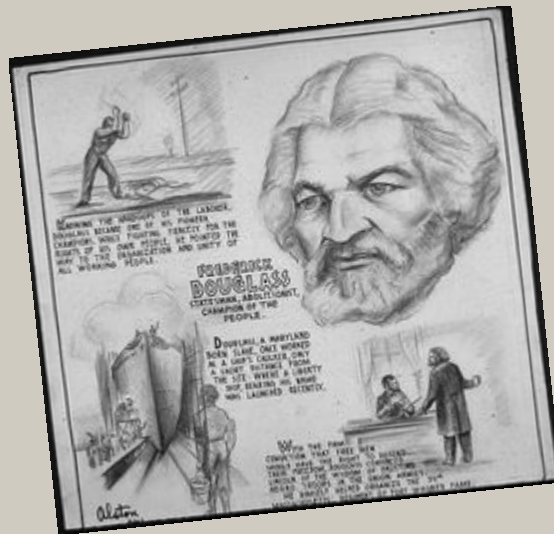
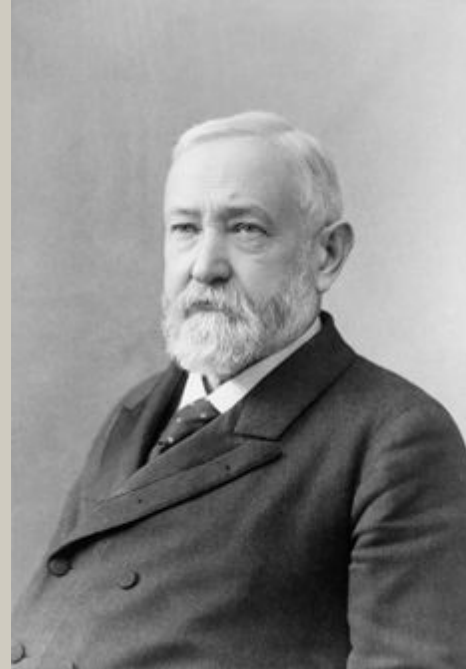

"There was no beds given to the slaves, unless a one coarse blanket." - Frederick Douglass



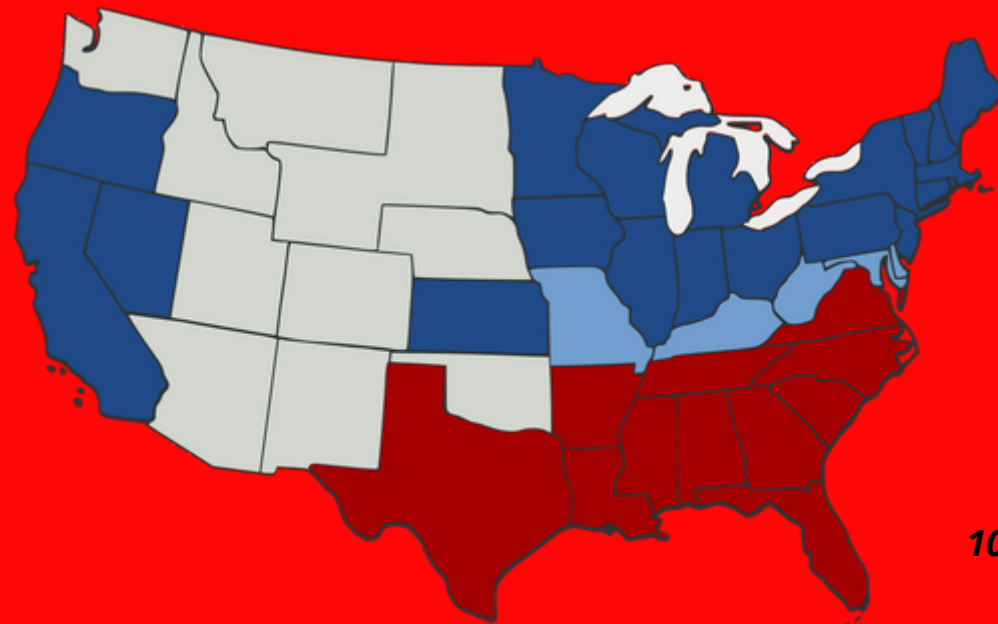

***Narrative**,(a spoken or written account of connected events; a story)

* **Allowance**,(the amount of something that is permitted)

***Monthly**,(occurring once a month)

***Excerpt**,(a short extract from a book)

***Recollect**,(to remember something)

***Uttering**,(to make a sound)

***Coarse**,(rough or loose in texture)

***Bitter**,(having a sharp pungent taste or smell)

***Horrid**,(causing horror)
