



Interest code: **SRE**

- Social** — Social occupations frequently involve working with, communicating with, and teaching people. These occupations often involve helping or providing service to others.
- Realistic** — Realistic occupations frequently involve work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They often deal with plants, animals, and real-world materials like wood, tools, and machinery. Many of the occupations require working outside, and do not involve a lot of paperwork or working closely with others.
- Enterprising** — Enterprising occupations frequently involve starting up and carrying out projects. These occupations can involve leading people and making many decisions. Sometimes they require risk taking and often deal with business.

- Leadership** — Job requires a willingness to lead, take charge, and offer opinions and direction.

#5 At the top of the page you will see INTERESTS with the 3 or 2 or 1 Interest letter. R I A S E C. CHECK THE DNA OF THE JOB TITLE YOU HAVE JUST CHOSEN TO SEE IF IT MATCHES YOUR DNA. If it does not, choose more job titles until you find several matches.

Real Life Scenario: Assume your student tells you he wants to be a police person.

- 1. The student takes the DNA assessment(s). (He now has a 3 letter DNA interest code.)**
- 2. The student takes the Career Cluster Survey. (He now has 3 clusters of interest in which he wishes to work.)**
- 3. Now the student uses ONET to find his top career cluster results. (He is now going to find out if police person is a match.)**
- 4. The student picks one of the 3—4 pathways AND one or more job titles.**
- 5. The student looks up the DNA code at the job title to see if it is a match for becoming a police person. (If it is not a match, he needs to explore more.)**
